

Music at St. Pius X

Music ministers serve the community by supporting the assembly's sung prayer, and by enriching the liturgy with music, old and new. There are many opportunities to be a part of music at St. Pius.

9:30 and 11:00 AM Sunday Morning Choir

A more traditional choral group, the Sunday Morning Choir sings a wide variety of music, old and new, from motets to spirituals. Rehearsals are Wednesday evenings and warm-ups are on Sunday mornings before Mass. This choir is a great place to learn the music of the church.

Women's Ensemble

The Women's Ensemble at St. Pius is a small group of women who excel at singing, sight read advanced level music, and blend their voices together to sing a varied range of music at Mass. This choir rehearses every other week, sings once per month at Mass, and is an auditioned choir.

5:00 PM Saturday Guitar Group

Singers, piano, guitar, woodwinds—the Celebration Group serves each Saturday, with rehearsals Saturday afternoon before mass at 4:00 p.m. Some sight-reading ability is helpful in this group. Singers and instrumentalists are scheduled, and this group remains flexible to accommodate a singer's schedule and family life.

Cantors

The cantor serves by guiding and supporting the community's sung prayer, as well as by proclaiming scripture in the Psalm and Gospel Acclamation. Musical experience and communication skills are essential for this ministry.

Christmas Choir (Midnight Mass)

For those singers who are unable to make a weekly commitment to singing, the Christmas Choir offers a short-term rehearsal schedule to join in singing for the liturgies of Christmas

Funeral Choir

The Funeral Choir serves by providing support through sung prayer for those who gather for funerals. Rehearsals are held thirty minutes before each funeral. No auditions are required.
